We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2010-2011 educational progress for the Belding Area Schools district and our schools. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal laws and some requirements of state laws; if needed, our staff is available to help you understand this information. Please contact any of our building principals or director of instruction and technology, Mike Burde, if you need assistance.

The report contains the following information:

Student Assessment Data– Michigan Educational Assessment Program (MEAP), Michigan Merit Exam (MME), and Michigan's Alternative Assessment Program (MI-Access)

- Presents achievement data for English language arts and mathematics for grades 3 to 8 (MEAP), for grade 11 (MME) and science for grades 5 and 8 compared to targets for all students as well as subgroups of students
- Provides achievement data for English language arts, mathematics and science for students with significant disabilities (MI-Access) compared to targets for all students with disabilities as well as subgroups of students
- Helps readers understand achievement progress within schools and compare these to district and state achievement

Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) – Detail Data and Status

Provides information from assessments, graduation and attendance rates and AYP status in relation to four criteria:

- The district must test 95% of students in total and in each required subgroup
- The district must attain achievement goals in English language arts and mathematics or reduce the percentage of students in the non-proficient category of achievement significantly ("safe harbor") annually
- The district must attain achievement goals for each subgroup that has at least 30 students in the group
- The district must meet or exceed the other academic indicators set by the state: graduation rate for high schools and attendance rate for elementary and middle schools

Teacher Quality Data

- Identifies teacher qualifications at district and school levels
- Reports percentage of core academic classes taught by teachers not considered highly qualified to teach such classes

NAEP Data (National Assessment of Educational Progress)

- Provides state results of the national assessment in mathematics and reading every other year in grades 4 and 8
- Cannot be compared with MEAP results for grades 4 and 8 because there are no national standards.

For 2010-2011, Belding Area Schools (as a district) made Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) in English language arts and mathematics. Additionally, Ellis Elementary, Woodview Elementary and Belding High School all made AYP. However, Belding Middle School did not make AYP. Below you will find the reason Belding Middle School did not make AYP and a summary of the actions underway to improve.

School Name	Reason(s) for not making AYP	Key actions underway to address the Issues
Belding Middle School	Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) was not met in the students with disabilities (SWD) subgroup in reading.	First, the annual objectives for reading at the middle school level increased 8% for the 2010-2011 school year. Under the 2009-2010 objectives, Belding Middle School would have made AYP. Secondly, the MEAP-ACCESS assessment was unavailable during the 2010-2011 school year. For a number of our students with disabilities, this is the most appropriate assessment in measuring student achievement levels; however, it was simply not an option. The MEAP-ACCESS will once again be available during the 2011-2012 school year and we are confident this assessment instrument will be a more accurate measure of student achievement. Lastly, continuous improvement efforts, at the local level, continue to focus on curriculum, assessment and coherence.

Once again, each of our buildings' main offices will have a letter and school specific AER to help answer your questions. These are also posted on the district and building web sites.

Finally, thank you to all of our students, staff, parents and those in our community that continue to be supportive of Belding Area Schools. You can be assured that the children of our community and their education are our first priority. The next few years are going to see us enter unchartered times with regards to funding, change and accountability. We need to continue to work hard and stick together so that Belding Area Schools emerges from this time of uncertainty as a leader in educating our children.

I am looking forward to the 2011-2012 school year and expect that it will be very exciting in terms of educational advances for our children and progress as our construction projects continue. It's a great time to be associated with Belding Area Schools. Remember, we have little control over what happens from the outside, but we can control how we respond and what we provide. I choose to provide all we can for our students and believe that we will overcome all obstacles to be the best school possible for our children. Thanking you for continuing to make Belding Area Schools, "The right size. The right choice."
