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### ~ Formal Dance Attire Guidelines~

In an effort to preserve the formal nature of this event, the following guidelines have been established by the administration and the student leadership groups:

- No Jeans and No Shorts
- No Casual Hats (baseball caps, visors, or stocking caps)
- No T-Shirts or Ripped Clothing
- No Tennis Shoes
- No Sunglasses
  
- Dresses must be of an appropriate length - mid thigh or longer.
- Slits in dresses must be of a modest nature - no revealing of undergarment or discreet body regions.
- Dresses must have side panels. No dresses with front-panels only that tie around the mid-section.
- Backless dresses are permitted so long as they meet the above requirement and come to the waist or higher.
- Strapless dresses are permitted so long as they meet the other requirements.
- Necklines on dresses must be modest (within reason) and not reveal excessive cleavage.
- Two-piece dresses are permitted, however the top piece must fit near (within 1 inch) the navel or below the navel.
- No dresses with navel "cut outs".
- Jewelry, make-up, or attire that is a safety concern or has the potential to present a disruption at the dance will result in a request to change by the administration or students will be required to leave the dance without refund.

Students who have any questions about attire are asked to bring in their clothing, jewelry, or make-up in advance to have it reviewed by an administrator.
